FINAL CALL FOR DUTCH COOKBOOK RECIPE SUBMISSIONS

LITTLE CHUTE, WI (November 2, 2009) – Little Chute Windmill, Inc. is accepting recipe submissions to be included in their new Dutch cookbook. Proceeds from the sale of the cookbooks will benefit the Little Chute Windmill Project, and will help preserve Dutch food traditions in northeast Wisconsin.

Recipe submissions must be Dutch in origin, or relate to the Netherlands or Dutch food in some way. Submissions must be accompanied by the author's name, and may include a history or anecdote about the recipe. Space is limited and not all recipes will be included in the cookbook.
