You may already know of the efforts to build an authentic Dutch windmill and visitor center in Little Chute, but here are some things you might not know.

Did you know...

- ... the Little Chute Windmill will stand 100 feet tall to the tip of the blade?
- ... the windmill will be partially constructed in The Netherlands and shipped over in pieces to be assembled here?
- ... the windmill will be fully functional and completely wind-powered?
- ... visitors will be able to tour the windmill and watch as volunteer millers grind grain into flour using centuries-old technology?
- ... at least 20,000 people are expected to visit The Little Chute Windmill and Visitor Center in its first year of operation?
- ... children may visit the windmill for free during the school year?
- ... most of the windmill's working parts are made of wood?
- ... there will be gardens with walkways and outdoor seating surrounding the windmill and visitor center?
- ... one of the gardens is going to be an educational vegetable garden where kids can participate in planting, growing and harvesting food?
- ... the visitor center will contain a gift shop, a museum display, a theater and a relaxation area?
- ... **Little Chute Windmill, Inc. has two main goals: to celebrate the Dutch heritage of the region and have a positive impact on the economy of Little Chute and the Fox Cities?**
